



COVID-19 PROTOCOL

The Church Council created a COVID Task Force (CTF) to research, evaluate and formulate updated COVID-19 protocol. The CTF will continue to monitor, evaluate and propose protocol changes as our church continues its journey home.

General:

- Masks are required inside the church when two or more people are present.
- Social distancing is practiced and encouraged.
- Hand sanitizer stations are located throughout the building.
- Do not enter church if you are not feeling well, experiencing symptoms or are COVID-19 positive.

Worship:

- Worship services are in person.
- Live stream and recorded services are available for remote viewing.
- Disinfecting is completed between services.
- Overflow seating, with access to a live stream, is provided in the courtyard.
- Masked singing is welcomed.
- A Welcome Station provides bulletins, communion cups and a member/visitor sign in.
- Offerings are collected via an onsite drop box, Simply Giving, Vanco Payment Portal or by mail.

Use of Facilities

- Church committees are welcome to hold in-person, socially distanced meetings within the church.
- Outside requests for the use of church facilities are reviewed and approved by the Senior Pastor and Council President.
- Sunday School is in-person and uses the Underground and classrooms.
- The nursery will open March 28, 2021.

Office Staff:

- When working independently, in a designated workspace, staff may work mask free.
- When moving about the office with others present, masks should be worn.
- Staff is expected to stay home if:
 - They are not feeling well or experiencing any COVID-19 symptoms.
 - They have encountered direct exposure to a potential COVID-19 case until one of the following occurs:
 - The case is confirmed negative.
 - If the case is positive, staff is expected to quarantine according to current CDC guidelines.
